Class of 2012 Stones

The unique tradition of the Alumni Wall was established in 1947 by members of the graduating class who wanted to leave their mark on this campus. Every year since that time, students have placed their stones on the wall just before they graduate from the Academy. Placing a stone on the Alumni Wall is an important part of becoming a WMA alumnus/a and a major part of our Commencement experience on Saturday, May 26. All students in the graduating class are expected to take part in the procession and place a stone on the wall.

The Prom

We are very happy to announce that Trustee and senior parent Suzy Awad has helped us secure her friend's restaurant, Post 390, in Boston for the Junior-Senior Prom. Her efforts have enabled us to offer a prom experience that ensures the safety of all our students throughout the night. The prom will be held on Saturday, May 5 from 10:00 PM – 2:00 AM. All students will depart from the Academy on school-provided coach buses at 8:30 PM and will return to the Academy around 4:00 AM. Before the prom, the Academy will host snacks and refreshments for the students and their parents. Upon their return to the Academy in the morning, the school will provide a light breakfast and then allow the students to leave campus at 5:00 AM. The estimated ticket prices are \$45 per person or \$80 per couple. Tuxedo and flower shops will be visiting WMA in the next few weeks to take orders; we will also arrange trips to local malls

to purchase any items needed, including prom dresses. The night of the prom, hair stylists will be on campus to help with hairdos, for a fee. Information will be updated on WMA News.

There will be door prizes at the Prom, and we would be grateful for any assistance parents can provide in this area. In the past everything from gift cards to computers and televisions have been donated, and students heading off to college are very appreciative of these items.

Class Agents and the Class of 2012 Banquet

With the 100-Day Celebration in February, the Alumni Office began working with the class as they make the transition from students to alumni. That day the students chose their Class Agents, those people who will keep in touch with their classmates as a communication link between the Class of 2012 and WMA. The Class of 2012 has a formal dinner with faculty and staff on Thursday evening, May 24. The banquet is designed to be an opportunity for students to remember their time here at the Academy and all of those people who are special to them. Dress Expectations for the Prize Day Ceremony and Commencement

Everyone attending is expected to be in dress code. Boys, and girls wearing slacks, must wear school blazers (with crest), for the Prize Day ceremony. As the guests of honor, the graduating class will want to look especially nice.

For the Commencement ceremony on Saturday, we ask girls to wear white dresses (skirts and tops are acceptable) and boys to wear white pants, white shirts, red ties (provided by the Academy), and WMA blazers (with crest). Girls will be carrying red roses and boys will have red carnations for their lapels.
