- FRIDAY MARCH 3** Depart USA for South Africa on International Flight **overnight**
- SAT MARCH 4** Arrive into Johannesburg, South Africa
Private Group Transfer to Garden Court Hotel in Sandton, Johannesburg **3 nights**
Daily breakfast is included
- SUN MARCH 5** Full Day History tour through Pretoria/Tshwane and Johannesburg to Voortrekker Museum, Union Buildings, lunch and Gold Reef City for mine visit & gold pour. Dinner included tonight.



- MON MARCH 6** Morning tour exploring Soweto with local expert guide
Visit to Hector Pieterse Apartheid Museum and lunch at nearby local house/café
Afternoon visit to Refugee 3 – 6 School to interact with refugee students or a visit and talk about “Plastic Town”, a place built out of scraps of cardboard, plastic and others trash as temporary dwellings by refugees, migrants and the very poor.

- TUES MARCH 7** Depart Johannesburg for the Cultural Experience at Lesedi Village **1 night**
Surrounded by the African bushveld this is a heritage themed eco-lodge providing a window into the cultures and traditions of five local tribes. The Zulu, Xhosa, Pedi, Basotho and Ndebele peoples show their traditional homesteads with crafts, art, song and dance.
Spend the night in one of the five homesteads and enjoy a traditional dinner tonight.



WED MARCH 8

Transfer after breakfast this morning to Pilanesberg National Park for our safari experience
Bakubung Bush Lodge with all meals included. **2 nights**
Evening Safari Game drive with experienced guides.

THUR MARCH 9

Relax and enjoy being in the bush!
Morning and Evening Game drives in open safari vehicles with experienced guides.
Be on the lookout for a variety of antelope, zebra, giraffe, elephant, lion, and even leopard!
Perhaps enjoy a Boma Dinner out under the stars and around the fire-pit.



FRI MARCH 10

A last morning Game drive and hearty breakfast before you set off for Johannesburg.

Private Group Transfer to the Radisson Red Hotel Cape Town **4 nights**
Table Mountain visit this afternoon* and dinner tonight included.

SAT MARCH 11

Full Day tour of the Cape Winelands. Historic and scenically beautiful region of some of the first European settlements to the southern tip of Africa.
Travel through to Franschhoek and Paarl settled by French Huguenot (1761) and early Dutch farmers and onto Stellenbosch for a historic walk & talk through some of the first Cape homes – living museums - and finally visit a working wine farm for a Segway tour through the estate.
Lunch included today.



SUN MARCH 12

Full Day Tour of the magnificent Cape Peninsula
Includes Penguins of Boulder Bay and climb to the look-out point at the crest of the continent
Optional funicular ride to the Look-out point. School visit to be incorporated in tour.
Lunch included today.

MON MARCH 13

Morning or Afternoon visit to Robben Island* with informative talk by a former guard.
Tour of Cape Town castle and Bo Kaap with District 6 visit. Free time to take in the Waterfront.
Shops, restaurants, galleries. Dinner tonight included.
