On-Campus Weekends

Long Weekends

- Boarding students must return to campus at the end of long weekend between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. the day before classes resume

Vacations

- Early departures or late returns for vacations are <u>not permitted</u> and considered unexcused absences. Parents must contact the Deans Office in advance to determine if a contemplated absence will be excused
- Boarding students must be out of the dorms by noon the day after vacation begins, with the exception of Winter Vacation (Dec. 20 by 5 p.m.)
- Boarding students must return to campus at the end of vacation between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. the day before classes resume
- Boarding students must leave campus for the following: fall, winter, spring and summer vacations
